FEBRUARY 2011 – SUE KEEN, SECRETARY TO THE MAYOR.

Ms. Keen presented a summary of the responsibilities of her office.

These include :

- Arranging weddings on the beach, (there were 38 during 2010) and obtaining a person to perform the ceremony
- Manage the electronic sign at the entrance to town
- Act as the go-between for events such as the Dune Grass planting and to arrange for supplies
- Run the Senior Center activities, including Bingo, cooking class, knitting. An attempt is made to add a new feature every year
- Prepare the annual Borough information card. The 2011 card will be a four-page glossy document that gives the phone numbers for all the utilities that serve the Borough so they can be notified of outages. There is information on the website and Comcast Channel 2.
- As an aside the feral cat program is coordinated. The program has resulted in a reduction in the number of cats. It is purely voluntary. Money is raised for veterinary bills, trapping, etc. A TNR fund is also run by the tax office. TNR is world-wide. It is estimated to save taxpayers \$18 billion.
- The Library sponsors the monthly cooking class and seats are filled within a couple of days after the announcement of each class.
- Bingo prizes are in the form of certificates from vendors in the Borough.

The President mentioned that AHLOA is looking into the purchase of a walk-around PA system for the Senior Center.
