JULY 2001 – BILL MACOMBER, DIRECTOR OF AVALON PUBLIC WORKS.

Bill was appointed Director by the Mayor in 2009. He gave a breakdown of the duties and experience of the twenty three full time employees in the Department as well as those of the two part time and two seasonal employees.

Public Works is responsible for contracts with contractors responsible for solid waste and recycling, waste dumpsters and bulk trash, lawn care, water and sewer, heating and air conditioning and for weed control. In addition, fifty two miles of road are maintained using between 80 and 100 tons of hot patch for repair of pot holes.

Last year DPW rebuilt the boardwalk from 30th to 32nd Streets at a cost of \$60,000. This year the area between 21st and 24* Streets was rebuilt at a cost of \$80,000. The plan is to complete the remainder of the boardwalk in 2012.

In the near future new roofs will be needed on the well buildings at 13* and 38* Streets. New siding, windows and landscaping will be needed at the 67* Street well house.

Road repair projects are being planned for 4* and 6* Avenues and for 5* Avenue or the 15* Street beach block if agreement can be reached on underground services. DOT will be carrying out repairs on 34* Street between Ocean and Dune Drives.
